

## **ERASMUS CHARTER FOR HIGHER EDUCATION 2021-2027**

We are pleased to announce that **SBS Swiss Business School in Malta** has been awarded the **Erasmus Charter for Higher Education (ECHE)**.

The **ECHE** is granted by the Erasmus+ Program to higher education institutions and serves as a **quality framework** for their participation in Erasmus+ activities. It outlines the principles and standards institutions must follow when engaging in international cooperation, mobility programs, and educational partnerships.

It is important to clarify that the ECHE is **not a personal certificate**, nor does it serve as an individual participation document. Instead, it certifies that an institution meets the required quality standards to participate in Erasmus+ initiatives. Individual certificates—such as those issued for student exchanges, internships, or study periods abroad—are provided separately to participants upon completion of their mobility activities.

For nearly three decades, the European Union has supported the Erasmus program, which has allowed more than **three million European students** to study or train in different countries across Europe. Erasmus+ continues this mission by offering opportunities for **students, teachers, staff, trainees, volunteers**, and individuals of all ages to gain international experience and enhance their skills.

The current Erasmus+ program for **2021–2027** places strong emphasis on:

- **Social inclusion**
- **Environmental sustainability (Green transition)**
- **Digital transformation**
- **Active youth participation**

It also supports the broader goals of the **European Education Area**, the **Digital Education Action Plan**, and the **European Skills Agenda**.
